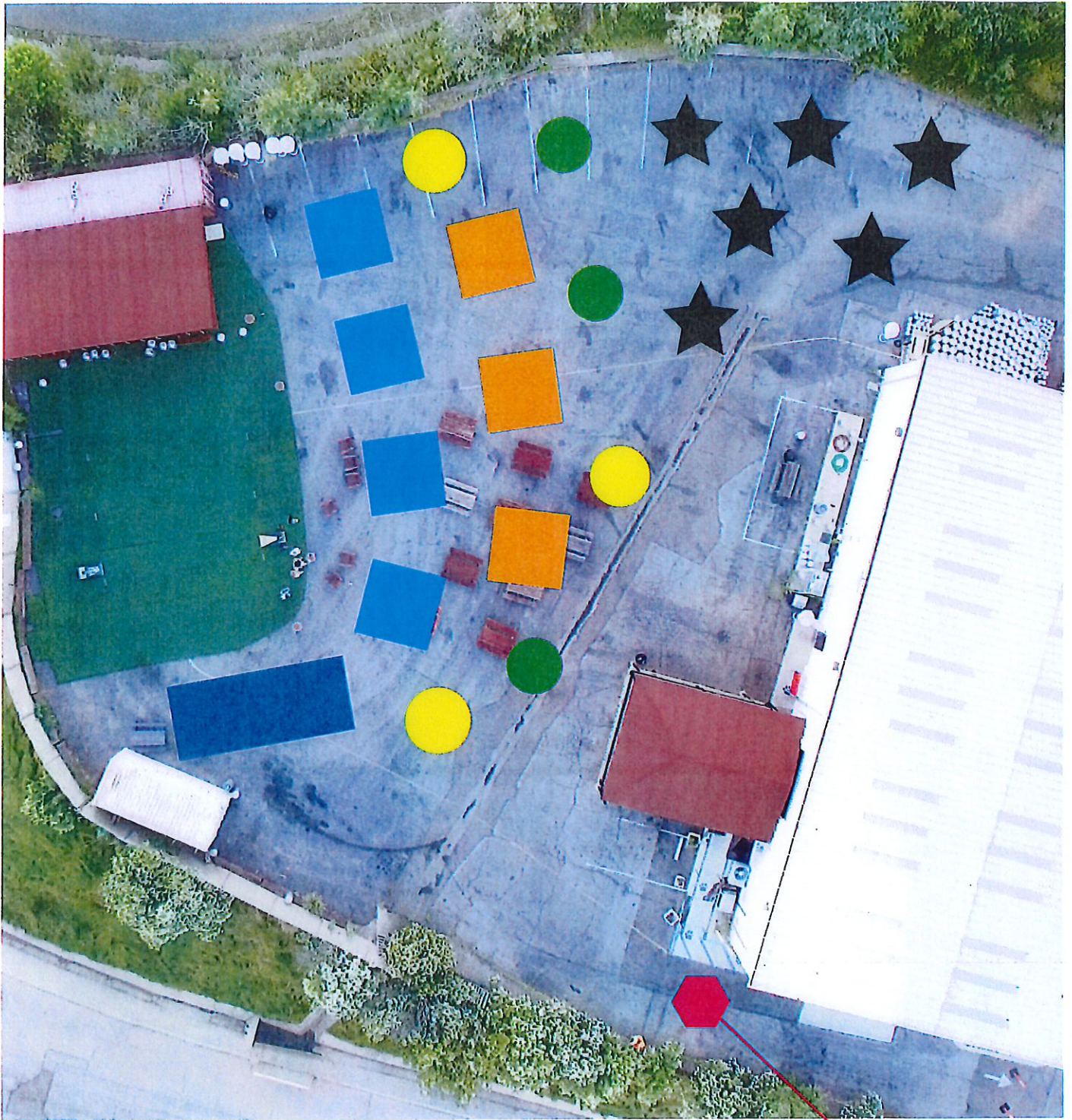

During this time, we want to reach out and update you on how we're approaching the situation and future fundraisers over the summer with Avenues Supported Living Services.

Like most organizations, we are doing our best to maintain social distancing to secure the health and well-being of the people we support, our staff and their families. For the past few months, our staff have been sheltered in place with one Avenues SLS client to one support staff to minimize their travel and to enable work from home. Avenues SLS has extended food distribution to twice a week organization in the office with home deliveries to all.

Moments like this, reminds us that we are all connected. We're called upon to be our best selves, with patience, understanding and compassion. Despite the many difficulties we all face, I'd like to re-assure you that Avenues Supported Living Services remains fully committed to doing everything we can to support your business and get others returning to you through this difficult time, and on behalf of the organization, wish you well.

With that in mind we are set to have our **4th Annual Cornhole Tournament and Virtual Silent Auction September 12, 2020**. We will make some adjustments this year. Such as, limiting playing groups to 50 per game, staggering the play times and offering player's club levels which includes a safe 10' x 10' space separated within social distance guidelines. Depending on the level chosen. In addition to shade and misters with the easy up shade per team (or family) lunch provided by Wolf Creek Restaurant and drink Coupons to the brewery will be an option. We will open our silent auction online a few days before the tournament and close it by the end of the tournament day on 9/12/20. All of these changes in hopes the community will feel safe and secure to participate. Or for sponsors to have advertising signs should they choose to sponsor a Player's Club tent in the absence of team players.

According to the State of California, Department of Social Services, "Person-centered individual program planning assists persons with developmental disabilities and their families to build their capacities and capabilities. This planning effort is a series of discussions or interactions among a team of people including the person with a developmental disability, their family (when appropriate), Regional Center representative(s) and others. This team assists individuals develop a description that includes: a preferred place to live, favorite people with whom to socialize, and preferred types of daily activities, including preferred jobs. This description is called a 'preferred future', and is based on the individual's strengths, capabilities, preferences, lifestyle and cultural background. Tax ID 94-3267511
